Our building site is definitely going Up! Both young and old are involved and there are thousands of supporters with gifts and prayers who are making it happen. Your prayers and gifts are bearing the building aloft and there will be all kinds of adventures of faith in the future!

It has been more than two years since we left the old MIC and growth has seemed slow, careful and deliberate - but like bamboo, after a slow germination period, it will rise up quickly. Already the sanctuary is taking shape and the scaffolding is reaching skyward.

Up describes our prayers – seeking God's wisdom in every aspect of the preparation for our new building. Praying for the refining of our vision for the building, clarifying the vision for its social service floors, the detail of the children's ministry made possible by its dedicated space, the resources needed to minister to young people, the operation of bible study and fellowship groups. Let us also pray for the safety of the construction team and wisdom as our construction committee guide the detail of the development.

Up describes our planning for the way the fabulous pastoral design of the building will be evidenced in the welcome people receive as they enter; the place to pause and pray, the small coffee shop at the ground floor. Up defines the foresight needed in our planning of the sanctuary and the rooms on each floor.

Up is (nearly), our time away from MIC. The congregations of MIC are beginning to see that we are past the tipping point of our time away from the MIC building. Already it is 26 months since we left and now we may only be 16 months before we return. Those months will soon be 'up' and with joy the congregations will return ahead of the official opening in the spring of 2018.

Up denotes the amount of funds being raised to pay for this remarkable redevelopment. We are already more than one third of

the way. I know I speak on behalf of all the MCHK leaders when I say 'Thank you!' to you for your generous and sacrificial giving. Of course there is significantly more to do but we have made substantial strides towards the final total. One aspect which we should note is that the cost is not going up. In fact we are presently on time and to budget. Our gratitude for that is due to Stuart Chen and his team of our members who work with Rocco's team and the Penta Ocean builders to ensure we have the right design at the best price.

On the 19 November we will be celebrating the laying of the Foundation Stone of the building. That is always a sign that the construction is confidently going Up. In the same way that a marriage ceremony is not the beginning of the relationship so the Foundation Stone Laying ceremony is not the commencement of the work. It is also a celebration of the confidence that the Church and its contractors have that this building will be completed, the fullness of its ministry will begin on time.

The bamboo scaffolding is going Up. It also becomes for us an image of what is happening to our whole Methodist Church in Hong Kong. Such scaffolding is strong and yet flexible, it resists the wind yet bends sufficiently not to be blown down. We resist aspects of the culture of Hong Kong, the obsessive consumerism of our society, the interference by administrators in the democratic process of who can stand for office; the neglect of the poor in a community of obvious wealth; but we have to live in this community as well as speaking prophetically to it; to deal with the art of the possible in community politics. For these reasons we are committed to our policies of Education, Social Services, Pastoral Care and Evangelism.

So in every way the new Methodist International Church and Conference Building is going 'Up'. May we rise to the challenge and demands of this remarkable project to the glory of God.


